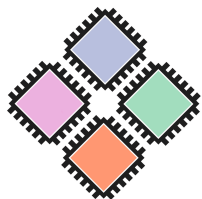

10am-12pm

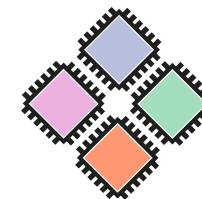
